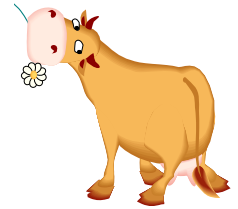

Whole Farm consultancy – Distance Education Post Graduate Training



CSU's School of Animal and Veterinary Sciences
is now offering you a great opportunity!



The new **Whole Farm Consultancy** is now offered through their Postgraduate course in Animal Science available through the School's Fred Morley Unit.

Too busy, can't get away from the business? No problems. The courses are by Distance Education, and you do them at your own pace. There is no residential requirement And much of the work is done with your own clients.

Not enough \$'s? Competitive scholarships worth **\$5,000** are available.

Not enough time? A suggested time frame for the Certificate is a subject per semester, completing it over two years. Candidates enrol in a Masters in Animal Science (12 subject equivalents), but can exit with a Certificate (4 subjects) or a Diploma (8 subject equivalents). For most, the 4 subject Certificate will give participants the outcomes they require, although for those wanting more, it is there.

The Certificate involves a core Whole farm Consultancy subject and three additional subjects which include carrying out whole farm investigations on your clients' farms. This is a real hands-on approach course, where you get to put into practice the theory. Successful participants will receive a Certificate, Diploma or Master in Animal Science.



The next intakes will be in Semester 1, 2012 and Semester 2, 2012. The number of places offered will be limited each semester. **Scholarships will be available for both the Semester 1 & 2 intakes**
